Harry Kyne has been the Finance Director for the City of Seminole, Pinellas County, since March 16, 1998. He is responsible for all aspects of accounting, financial reporting, debt management, cash management, payroll & investments for the City of Seminole. In 1999, his position was changed to Director of Administration, and he also oversees the general operation of the Library Division, IT Division, Recreation Division and Risk Management. The City received its first Comprehensive Annual Financial Report in 1998 and has continued to receive this annual CAFR award for the last 17 years. The City also has received the GFOA Distinguished Budget Award every year since 2007. He is a member of the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA), Florida Government Finance Officers Association (FGFOA), and Gulf Coast FGFOA Chapter where he has served on the Board of Directors for two years and was President in 2005-2006. In 2005, he was named the Florida League of Cities' "Finance Official of the Year" at their annual meeting. He currently serves on the Board of Directors of the Public Risk Management of Florida Health Care Trust (PRMT). He was president for four years of the Seminole High School Soccer Booster Club and the Seminole High School Track and Cross Country Booster Club. He was also Scoutmaster of a Seminole Boy Scout Troop for 8 years.

Prior to entering into governmental finance, he spent 11 years in the Funds Management Department for Fortune Bank, Clearwater, Florida, and held the position of Vice President of Funds Management. While at the bank, he was responsible for maintaining the liquidity position, and overseeing corporate borrowing, the jumbo CD desk and trading of bank owned mortgage backed securities. After the bank was sold in 1993, he spent five years at St. Pete Beach as a Budget Officer until he left to become Finance Director in Seminole.

Harry has a B.A. from Villanova University and a Masters Certificate in Public Administration from the University of South Florida.
